FINANCE UPDATE



Financial Data—. The weekly average tithing for April was \$4,145, which was good. We have \$11,114 in the General fund, with our expenses averaging approximately \$10,000/month. Our year-to-date income is \$8,565 greater than the plan. Our year-to-date expenses are \$3,955 greater than the plan.

First Quarter results versus the budget – The Financial Statements have been reviewed.


RESPITE PROGRAM UPDATE
