- Do you have any ideas for possible future events that could be held at church and would encourage participation from our community? If so, please put your ideas in the suggestion box – which will be located by the entryway.


NURTURE OUTREACH UPDATE

UPDATE ABOUT FAMILY PROMISE

Family Promise Supporters,

As of April 1st, our last family being sheltered at our Day Resource Center (DRC) will graduate into their own home and our doors here for sheltering in Lyons will close. The DRC building will be placed on the market.

With the closing of one door comes the opening of another. On Monday April 7th we will be moving into the First United Methodist Church in Newark. This is where we will hold our office space, meetings, case management will continue. Roof Over Their Heads (ROTH) will continue, which provides Prevention/Diversion to families locally. Shelter is on hold until such time we can acquire multi units/office space in one building so we can continue our shelter mission work. Our hope is to take that one step back, so that we can take a GIANT leap forward by saving and building our funding for general funds and our building fund.

Family Promise of Wayne County NY Inc has Sheltered 61 families (72 adults and 147 children) since we opened our doors to the first family October 20, 2018. Out of the 61 families 53 successfully completed our program and all 53 are still self-sustaining in the community. Our Roof Over Their Heads (ROTH) program started August 2021 and since has provided one-time financial assistance to 198 as of March 14th. That is 226 adults and 435 children. We are averaging about \$701.26 in one time assistance per family.

The board is working diligently alongside staff on this and we will be continuing to work together for FPWC, for our mission and for the families in our community that we have yet to reach! Prayers and support are much needed and very welcomed during this time of transition. We are feeling very positive about these next steps and hope you will continue to join us on this journey!
