Financial Data – The weekly average tithing for Nov. was \$2,656. The General Fund is at \$2,550 which is the low. The year-to-date income is \$11,615 greater than the plan. The year-to-date expenses are \$16,261 great than the plan. Though our tithing has been very good, our expenses have been very high, thus the low amount in the General Fund.
